The Goldfield Ranch Homeowners Association board meeting was held Monday, February 8 at 7pm at the home of Janet and Dave Heekin. Present at this meeting were Janet Heekin, Ed Zukowski, Karl Mann and Geno Mei.

Meeting was called to order by GRHA President, Janet Heekin at 7:15. Minutes from GRHA's January meeting were discussed and one change was made before approval.

Individual roles of the current board were discussed. The GRHA President for the 2010 term will be Janet Heekin. Ed Zukowski will be Vice President and Geno Mei will take on the duties of Treasurer.

A treasurers'/membership report was presented by Janet Heekin showing that the current GRHA balance is \$3867.00. Board members are encouraged to remind any neighbors that have not yet paid their 2010 dues to please do so. A friendly reminder will be sent out to Goldfield residents in the next bulletin written by Janet.

Everyone should have received their Emergency Phone Tree lists a few months ago. Janet is to check with Anne Dutton as to when she is planning a test of the system.

A discussion was held regarding the current status of the roads. All board members agreed that only positive comments have been heard and neighbors are happy with the test strips at this time. In six months time, the test strip will be re-evaluated to see how it holds up in our dry summer heat.

The board members discussed ways to discourage speeding on our roads in order to provide for the safety of our resident. Although posted speed signs are not enforceable, possibly friendly reminders located along the main streets would be beneficial.

Several residents have mentioned that a homeless person has been seen wandering along the Beeline Hwy and Goldfield Ranch area. Although no damage or harassment has been reported, Board members will encourage neighbors to keep their eyes open and will keep residents updated to any changes.

Trash cleanup day is set for Saturday, February 20 at 9:00am. Please meet at mile marker #196 with trash bags and gloves to receive your cleanup location.

Copies of the GRHA bylaws will be given to new board members Karl Mann and Geno Mei by Janet.

The GRHA Board requests that any residents that would like to share useful/helpful information with their neighbors do so by submitting this information to a board member. These helpful tips will be posted in the monthly bulletins.

The date of our March Board meeting is to be determined after February 19. Future Board meetings will be scheduled towards the end of each month.
