A treasurers' report was presented by Geno Mei and indicated that the current GRHA balance is \$4057.27. Board members are encouraged to remind any neighbors that have not yet paid their 2010 dues to please do so.

An Emergency Phone Tree test was run by Anne Dutton and according to the response she received; only 40% of the resident were contacted. The GRHA will check into a service that provides one number that any resident can call and the service will contact all names on the Phone Tree. Geno will check with Al Glenister regarding the system that is used by the Fire District.

Several Goldfield residents have inquired when the rest of the roads will be completed. The test strips are still in the testing stage and nothing further will be done until results are in. The GPOA needs to see how this treatment holds up during our hot summer months before a decision can be made.

Greg Calvin inquired on the possibility of putting up traffic control signs at certain busy intersections. The costs that would be involved will be investigated and the results will then be presented. Greg and Ed will work on this project.

A new item to be added to our bulletin board will be a rattlesnake count to date. Karl Mann will update the board regularly as residents let us know when they see one.

Board members will check into the county ordinances and CCR's regarding the proper placement of real estate signs. Some residents have voiced concern over the current status of real estate signs in the neighborhood.

Trash cleanup day was a success. Thanks to all who participated!

Some weeding and work around the mailbox area was suggested. Geno will take on this project.
