Board Member Marty White recently expressed frustration with the lack of progress in getting another test strip done. Marty said that the use of Magnesium Chloride is still an option being considered for our roads, but the MgCl product requires periodic maintenance with the application of water. And as anyone knows who lives in the desert, water is not easy to come by and is expensive. We can no longer depend upon water from the well on the Preserve property. So additional products are being considered for our roads. The newest product that many of the Board members are hoping to test is a pine tar solution. This product is more expensive than the MgCl product, but does not require water to maintain it. Most members of the GPOA Board are hoping to see this new product tried out here with a test strip. This test strip is being offered free to us at Goldfield Ranch. Hence the reason for the delay in moving forward on this project is a mystery. Is there something wrong with "free"? As Marty says, "Ask Doug". Hopefully we will see progress on this new test strip within a few weeks. It will probably be put down on Vista del Oro from Boothill to Burntwater.
