Following are our four nominee's bios, which they each have provided. We thank them all for running!

**Theresa Frankin:** Theresa has lived in Goldfield with her husband, Robin, and three sons since 2002 and in Arizona since 1972 when her parents moved to Fountain Hills to build homes. She was
